



Michigan Middle Start Southeast Regional Network School Leadership Seminars

Building a professional learning community offers inclusive support of a whole school. The school leadership seminars will help a small school team build the understanding of what it takes to produce strong, lasting, positive change in a school. The seminars will help the team build the capacity of their school to focus on whole school change and improve the practices of teaching and learning in the school. The seminars will focus on developing:

- a distributed base of leadership in the school,
- a professional learning community in the school,
- skills for teacher collaboration and
- skills for critical analysis of student work.

Each school may send a team of four people. The team must include the building principal and three additional teachers of other professional staff. i.e. counselors, instructional specialists etc..

Dates for the seminars for the 2004-5 school year are:

February 15, March 15, April 20 and May 17. An additional seminar will be scheduled for the fall of 2005. Seminars will be from 8:30am to 3:30pm for each session. Schools will need to schedule substitutes for their participating teachers (see district personnel for your school limit).
